

## "LEVEL UP SCHOOL DAYS 2020": VIDEO GAME LESSONS WITH FACEBOOK, SONY AND ESA

## THREE DAYS DEDICATED TO YOUNG PEOPLE WHO WANT TO TAKE A CAREER PATH IN VIDEO GAME INDUSTRY; NEW TECHNOLOGIES AND DIGITAL ENTERTAINMENT

Rome, 25th September 2020. Let the countdown begins for LEVEL UP - School Days, the very first and unique event in Italy entirely dedicated to the creation and development of video games, simulations and interactive works, created and organised by AIV - Italian Academy of Video Games, in collaboration with Polo Tecnico Professionale Galileo. Three days of simulations and interactive works for young students interested in working in the video games industry. From Monday 28th to Wednesday 30th September, inside ITIS Galileo Galilei in Rome, there will be some of the most important international institutions talking about how digital skills are pivotal in the job market and represent a fly-wheel for the economy.

During three days of institutional and tech panels, talks, workshops, Virtual Reality and simulators area, indie area and the Game Jam "Students for Future" – **LEVEL UP School Days** will bring in Rome all the latest news about Sciences and Technologies of Interactivity.
